
STAAR Alternate 2 End-of-Course 2018 Test Administration



Reporting Student Data File Format

Overview

STAAR End-of-Course (EOC) and STAAR Alternate 2 EOC results are reported separately. However, the file format for STAAR EOC and STAAR Alternate 2 EOC are the same for fields that are the same on both assessments. For example, fields like the ECONOMIC-DISADVANTAGE-CODE and SCORE CODE (and many others) will be found in the same positions on both files.

Following is a list of the most significant changes being implemented in 2018.

- Added SPECIAL-ED-INDICATOR-CODE, GIFTED-TALENTED-INDICATOR-CODE, and AT-RISK-INDICATOR-CODE in the Demographics Information section (see positions 111, 117, and 118 respectively).
- Removed value of 3 from CAREER-AND-TECHNICAL-ED-INDICATOR-CODE (see position 122).
- Removed DOCUMENT NUMBER (previously in positions 132-140).
- Added TRANSLATED STUDENT MATERIALS (see position 308).

NOTE: The data will be provided in a fixed-length text file format with the layout defined below. The file extension will be .dat. Tab-delimited files are not available.
