Data File Format with Student Item Analysis

Overview of Changes

Ethnicity and Race Codes: Beginning with the 2009-2010 school year Texas schools will begin reporting ethnicity and race data for students using the new requirement issued by the United States Department of Education. The following fields have been added to address this requirement:

- **Hispanic-Latino-Code:** This information can be found in position 93.
- **American-Indian-Alaskan-Native-Code:** This information can be found in position 94.
- **Asian-Code:** This information can be found in position 95.
- **Black-African-American-Code:** This information can be found in position 96.
- **Native-Hawaiian-Pacific-Islander-Code:** This information can be found in position 97.
- **White-Code:** This information can be found in position 98.

PEIMS Student Attribute Code: The student attribute code indicates whether a student attends an open enrollment charter school, is served in a JJAEP, attends school in the district through a PEG Grant, attends school as a transfer between school districts or attends school in a district, yet lives outside the state of Texas. This information can be found in positions 176-177.

Reading Score Code Default: The Reading Score Code Default value of '2' was updated to reflect students in Grade K-1 whose enrolled grade did not match the tested grade cluster (applies only to online). This field is in position 277.

Reading Test Administration Format: Previously 'Reading Paper Testing Administration', this field now indicates if the student tested on paper or online. If the student tested online, this field will indicate which format of the online test was administered to the student. This field is in position 333.

Attention Macintosh Users

To accommodate Macintosh systems a delimiter has been placed after each data field in your file (Hex = 05). For example, the first data field, Administration Date, has a field length of 4 and is followed by a delimiter in field 5. Therefore, the data field for Enrolled Grade-Level-Code begins in field 6 rather than field 5 as shown in the data file format.
