## Reporting Data File Format

## Overview of Changes

- Previously the Years in U.S. Schools field (position 141) had values of 'F', 'S', '2', '3', '4', '5', and '6'. Beginning in 2016, the values of 'F' (first enrolled in the first semester) and 'S' (first enrolled in the second semester) will no longer be collected. Instead a value of '1' will be collected indicating that the student is in his or her first year in a U.S. School (regardless of which semester the student was enrolled).
- ELL Plan Information was added to the TELPAS data file (positions 219-230)
- In grades $2-12$ the reading score code will be defaulted to ' B ' instead of ' O ' when a reading test is not submitted for a student and the holistic ratings for listening, speaking, and writing are submitted. (position 276).
- The score code default fields have been removed (positions 232, 247, 262, and 277) because the value could only be a ' 1 ' when the score code was a ' B '.


## Attention For Users of Tab-delimited Files

If you ordered a tab-delimited file, a delimiter has been placed after each data field in the file ( $\mathrm{Hex}=05$ ). For example, the first data field, Administration Date, has a field length of 4 and is followed by a delimiter in position 5. Therefore, the data field for Grade-Level-Code begins in position 6 rather than position 5 as shown in the data file format.

## YEARLY PROGRESS INDICATOR

This value will indicate the proficiency level progress if the current year record can be matched to a previous year record. This field will be blank if a match was not made.

## TELPAS COMPREHENSION SCORE

The Comprehension Score is determined from the listening and reading language area proficiency ratings. Each language area rating is weighted $50 \%$ towards the comprehension score. The comprehension score will range from 1.0 to 4.0. If either the listening or reading ratings are not available, a comprehension score of 0.0 will be present.

## TELPAS COMPOSITE SCORE

The Composite Score is determined from the four language area ratings. The weights assigned to each of the language area ratings are given in the table below. If one of the four language area ratings is not present, a composite score cannot be determined and will result in a composite score of 0.0.
