

# **Attention Macintosh Users**

To accommodate Macintosh systems a delimiter has been placed after each data field in your file (Hex = 05). For example, the first data field, Administration Date, has a field length of 4 and is followed by a delimiter in field 5. Therefore, the data field for Enrolled Grade-Level-Code begins in field 6 rather than field 5 as shown in the data file format.

### **RPTE ITEM DATA**

#### 343-402 60 **ITEM PROFICIENCY LEVEL** (1 position per item)

The number in each field indicates the proficiency level of the corresponding test item. For example, the value in the first field, position 343, indicates the proficiency level for item 1. The second field, position 344, indicates the proficiency level for item 2, and so on.

- 1 = Beginning Proficiency Level item
- 2 = Intermediate Proficiency Level item
- 3 = Advanced Proficiency Level item

#### 403-462 60 **ITEM OBJECTIVE NUMBERS** (1 position per item)

The number in each field indicates the objective measured by the corresponding item (value = 1-4). For example, the value in the first field, position 403, indicates the objective measured by item 1. The second field, position 404, indicates the objective measured by item 2, and so on.

### 463-522 60 **CORRECT ITEM RESPONSE** (1 position per item)

The character in each field indicates the correct response to the corresponding test item (value = A-D or F-J).

#### 523-582 60 **STUDENT ITEM RESPONSE** (1 position per item)

The character in each field indicates the student's response to the corresponding item. The student's response to item 1 is in the first field, position 523, the student's response to item 2 is in the second field, position 524, and so on. Correct responses are indicated by a plus sign (+); an alpha character (A-D or F-J) indicates an incorrect response; and an asterisk (\*) indicates that the response was left blank or multiple values were gridded.

#### 583-583 1 YEARLY PROGRESS INDICATOR

This value will indicate the proficiency level progress if the current year record can be matched to a previous year record. This field will be blank if a match was not made.

- 0 = The student's composite rating is lower or the same as the previous year's rating\*
- 1 = The student's composite rating is one level higher than the previous year's rating\*
- 2 = The student's composite rating is two levels higher than the previous year's rating
- 3 = The student's composite rating is three levels higher than the previous year's rating
- \* The yearly progress indicator is set to 1 if a student is advanced high in the current and previous year

#### 584-586 3 TELPAS COMPREHENSION SCORE

The comprehension score is determined from the listening and reading language area proficiency ratings. Each language area rating is weighted 50% towards the comprehension score. The comprehension score will range from 1.0 to 4.0. If either the listening or reading ratings are not available, a comprehension score of 0.0 will be present.

#### 587-589 3 TELPAS COMPOSITE SCORE

The composite score is determined from the four language area ratings. If one of the four language area ratings is not present, a composite score cannot be determined and will result in a composite score of 0.0.
